

Guidelines for Veteran & Citizen Action Team

1. *The Buffalo and Erie County Naval & Military Park (“Naval & Military Park”) Veteran & Citizen Action Team will be open to any interested Veteran or Citizen, who is willing to assist us in making the park a premier destination for local residents and visitors from around the world.*
2. *The duties of membership are 100% voluntary.*
3. *Currently, there is no maximum limit on the number of members of the Action Team; however, that is subject to review by the Board of Directors of the Naval & Military Park.*
4. *Members of the Action Team will be asked to perform the following duties:*
 - A. *Act as Ambassadors for the Naval & Military Park in their communities;*
 - B. *When visiting the Naval & Military Park during the season, provide us with counsel and insights about how we can improve a guest’s or veteran’s experience at the park.*
 - C. *When visiting the Naval & Military Park, report any serious condition or problems to the staff on duty.*
5. *The following benefits will be provided to Action Team members:*
 - A. *Membership Card entitles members free admission to the Naval & Military Park for one year and your visitors will receive a discount;*
 - B. *Certificate of Membership at year’s end;*
 - C. *Access to the Naval & Military Park’s online e-newsletter;*
 - E. *Ten percent (10%) discount on all purchases from the gift shop by showing your card.*
6. *There will be two (2) Action Team Meetings each year. The first will occur in the spring, near the park opening, so we may share our plans, calendar and needs for the upcoming season. The second will occur in the fall to celebrate our season, review the year’s activities, and suggest ideas for the following season.*
7. *As members of the Action Team you will have an opportunity to serve on other park committees and assist with activities throughout the year.*
