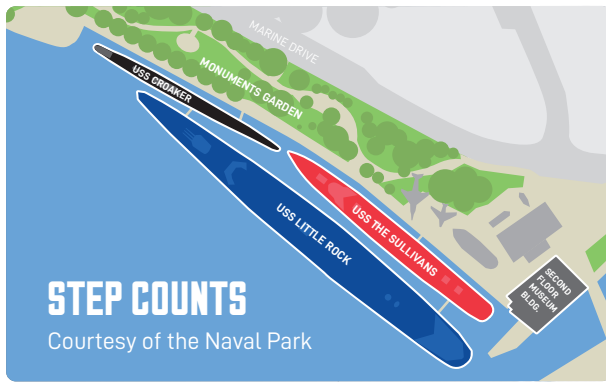

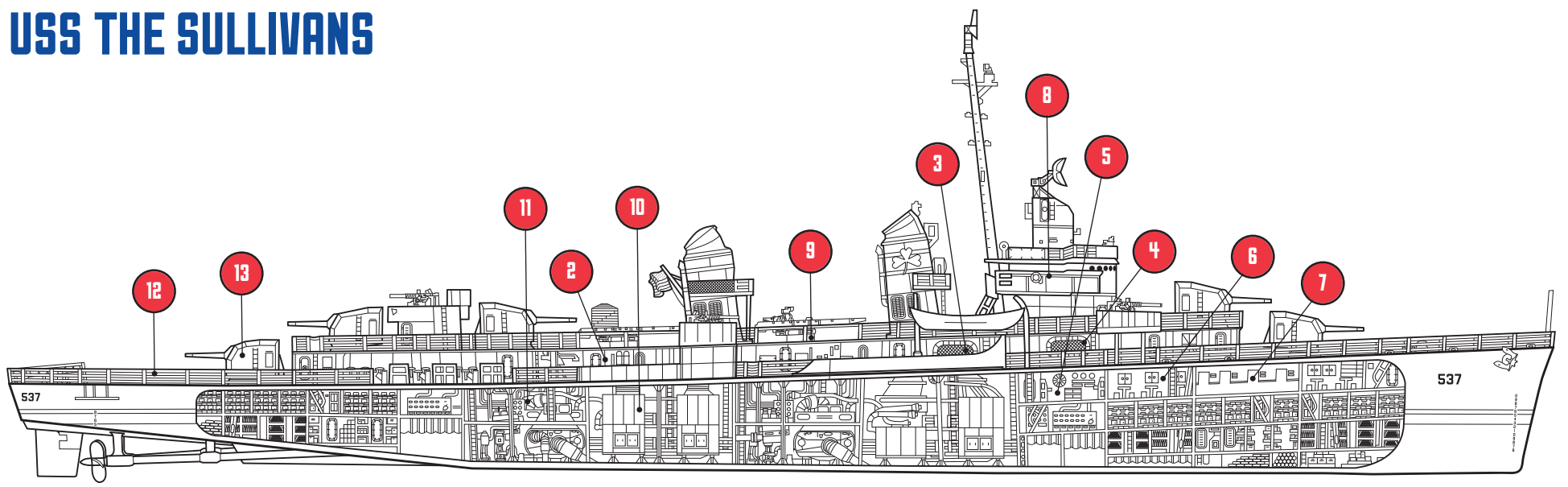


AUDIO TOUR – NOTES & FUN FACTS

- **Volume** can be controlled by the "+" and "-" on the unit
- **Stand at the red anchors** painted on the deck and hold the unit away from you to pick up the audio
- **When at an anchor** if it doesn't play right away look for the corresponding number and punch it into the unit number pad
- **Follow the yellow line** and yellow arrows during your tour!
- **Stop 2** plays three top songs from 1943, the year USS The Sullivans was commissioned
- **Stop 13** plays three top songs from 1965, the year USS The Sullivans was decommissioned
- **Stop 25** plays three top songs from 1976, the year USS Little Rock was decommissioned

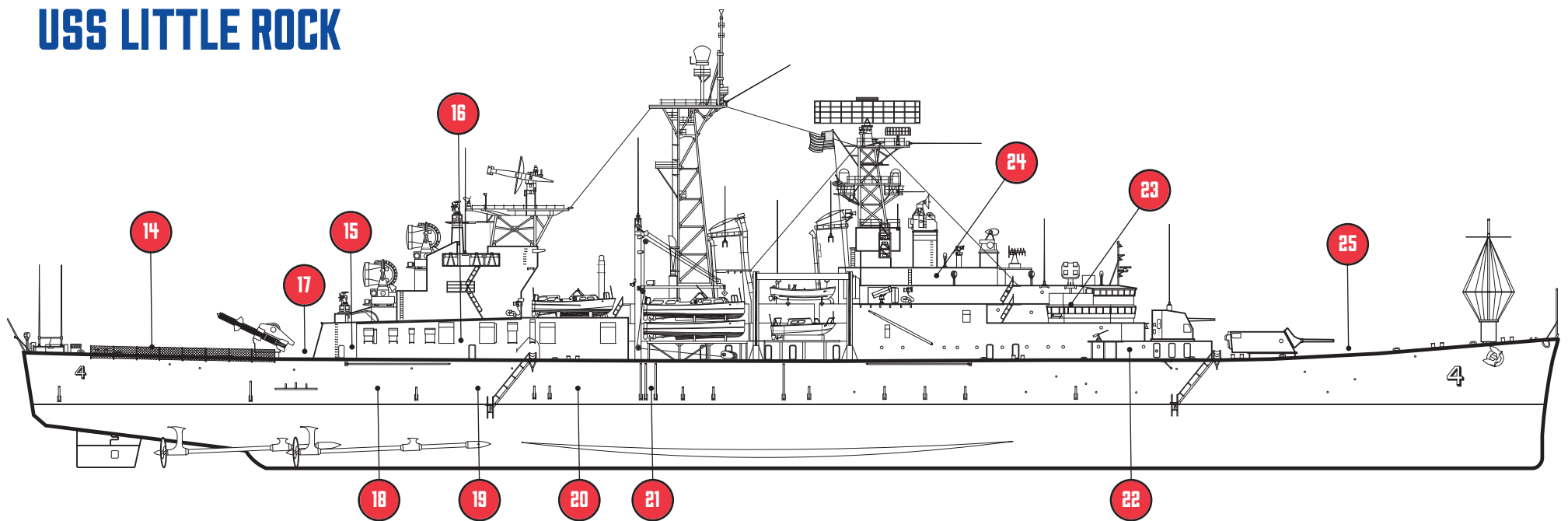

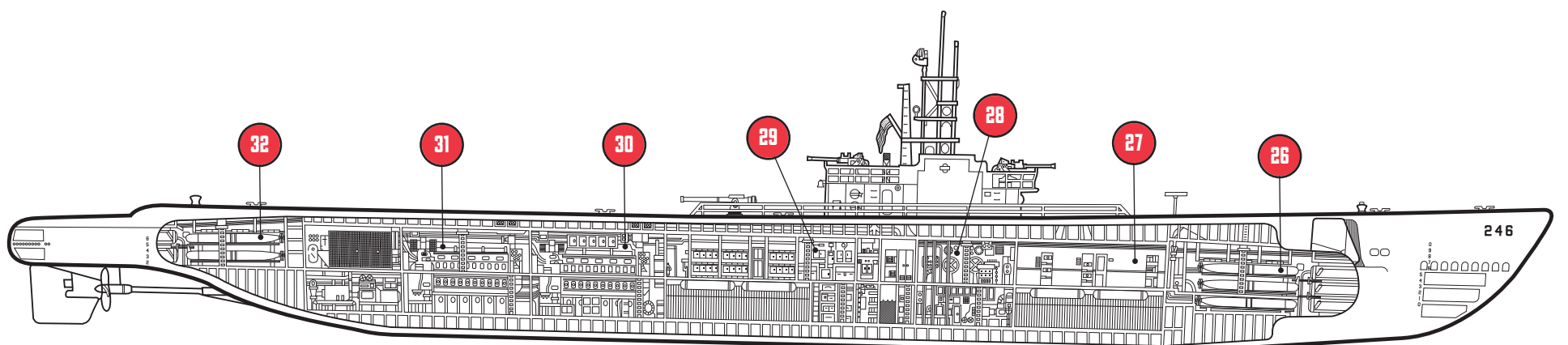
